
Traditional Dental Plans

Effective January 1, 2008, the following change is made to your plan:

The definition of **Necessary Service** in the **Definitions** section is revised as follows:

“Necessary Service: Means a dental service recommended by the treating dentist or other provider, who has personally evaluated you, and determined by the Company to be all of the following:

Appropriate, based upon the symptoms, for determining the diagnosis and management of the condition;

Appropriate for the diagnosed condition, disease or injury in accordance with recognized national standards of care;

Not able to be omitted without adversely affecting your condition; and

Not primarily for the convenience of you, your family or your provider.

A dental service may be a “Necessary Service” yet not be a covered service under this plan.”
